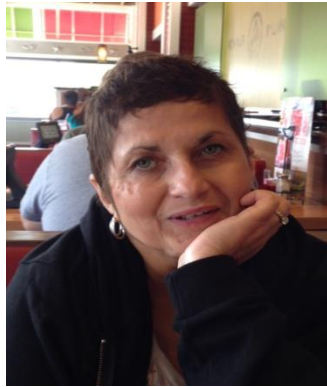

## OPPORTUNITIES TO GIVE

- **Manna Market;** This ministry is a market where members exchange vouchers received for attending church for basic food items. The Market has no sponsor. As funds come in we send them out. We have not been able to fund this ministry since late spring.
- **Least of These:** This ministry supplies prepared meals for the poorest of families in Tinca during the harshest time of the year. It is sponsored by our 2 US Gypsy Outreaches. It could always use more help.
- **Christmas and Easter Food and Toy/Candy Baskets:** With the churches growing by leaps and bounds with new members, this ministry has grown at a very rapid pace. It has no particular sponsor. I try my best to save throughout the year but always come up short. We are now preparing food baskets, (toys and candy for children) for about 200 Roms families. Then of course the same amount of baskets at Easter. We use to get Christmas shoeboxes from Samaritans' Purse, but in recent years have been eliminated from their giving list.
